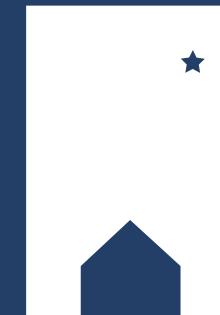

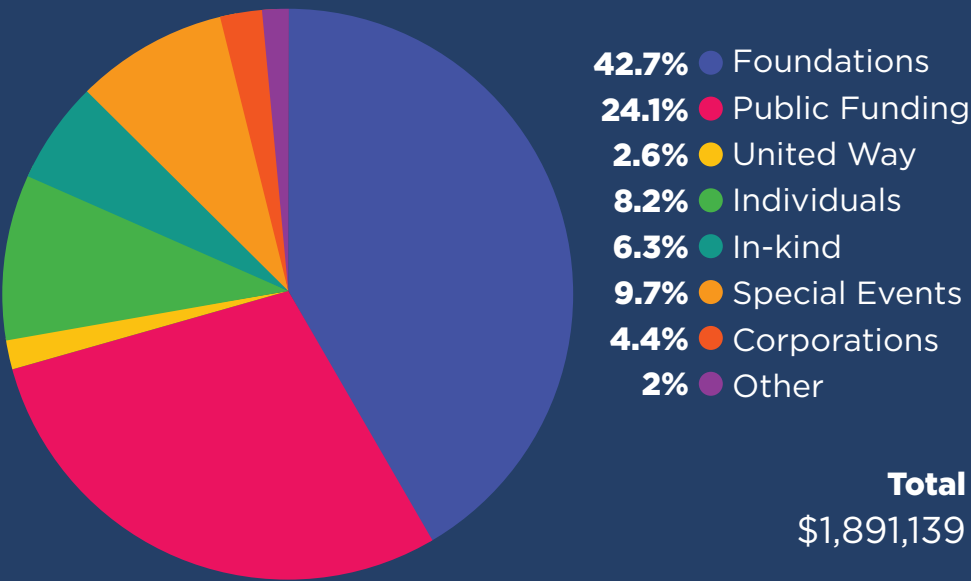
Our Impact

For pregnant or newly parenting young parents, including teens

Focus on building parent/child attachment combined with developmental assessments and goal planning to encourage staying in school and/or employment.

88%	Improved protective factors

98%	Not referred to CPS

Parent Aide

For families at elevated risk for abuse

Therapeutic services combined with positive parenting skills, family goal planning and developmental assessments to achieve a nurturing home environment.

200	Parents and children served
94%	Decreased risk for abuse
94%	Parents employed or in school
88%	Not referred to CPS
