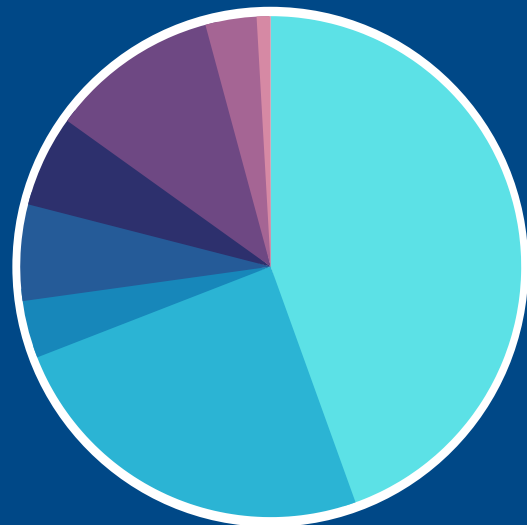

Growing As Parents (GAP)

For pregnant or young new parents, including teens

Builds parent-child attachment, administers developmental assessments, and implements goal planning to encourage parents to stay in school and/or employment.

394 Parents & children served

83% Improved protective factors

87% Parents employed or in school

100% Not referred to CPS



Home mentoring costs the agency \$34 per person per visit, provided at no cost to families.

Parent Aide

For families at elevated risk of child abuse

Therapeutic services that teach positive parenting skills, family goal planning, and use of developmental assessments, ultimately achieving a nurturing home environment.
