
2,184 Children and parents served in 2023. *18% accessed more than one program.*

Home Mentoring

Growing As Parents (GAP)

For pregnant or new parents, including teens

Builds parent-child attachment, administers developmental assessments, and implements goal planning to encourage parents to stay in school and/or employment.

- 396** Parents & children served
- 92% Improved protective factors
- 91% Parents employed or in school
- 99% Not referred to CPS



Home Mentoring costs the agency \$32 per person per visit, provided at no cost to families.

Parent Aide

For families at elevated risk of child abuse

Wrap-around Home Mentoring services delivered through a therapeutic lens, teaching positive parenting skills, family goal planning, and provides developmental assessments to achieve a nurturing home environment.

- 185** Parents & children served
- 96% Decreased risk factors
- 97% Parents employed or in school
- 79% Not referred to CPS

Community Education & Outreach

Bringing Families Together

Serves families in transitional & supportive housing

Implements the nationally accredited Positive Parenting Program (Triple P) to build confidence in parenting, deal with problem behavior, create nurturing and positive relationships, and teach parenting self-care.

- 17** Communities impacted
- 91% Improved protective factors

Community Education Classes

Provides education within schools, jails, childcare facilities, and other partner agencies

Teaches child abuse prevention curriculum, infant and toddler safety topics, and car seat safety.

- 413** Parents served
- 94** Professionals trained by our seminars
- 72% Increased infant safe sleep knowledge
