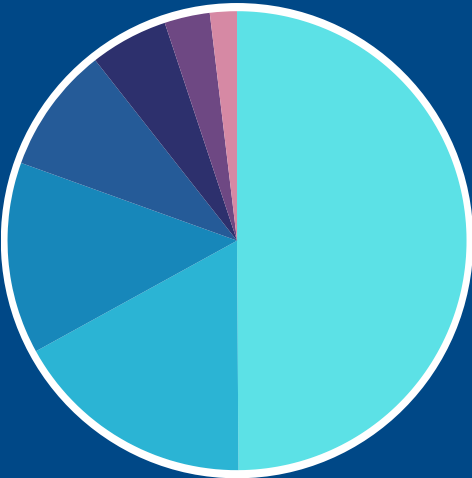

Home Mentoring

Growing As Parents (GAP)

For pregnant or new parents, including teens

Builds parent-child attachment, administers developmental assessments, and implements goal planning to encourage parents to stay in school and/or employment.

96%	Decreased risk factors

Home Mentoring costs the agency \$30 per person per visit, provided at no cost to families.

Parent Aide

For families at elevated risk of child abuse

Wrap-around Home Mentoring services delivered through a therapeutic lens, teaching positive parenting skills, family goal planning, and provides developmental assessments to achieve a nurturing home environment.

Community Education & Outreach

Bringing Families Together

Serves families in transitional & supportive housing

Implements the nationally accredited Positive Parenting Program (Triple P) to build confidence in parenting, deal with problem behavior, create nurturing and positive relationships, and teach parenting self-care.

Community Education Classes

Provides education within schools, jails, childcare facilities, and other partner agencies

Teaches child abuse prevention curriculum, infant and toddler safety topics, and car seat safety.
